PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

Volunteers will carry out activities for 5 days a week, mostly during the morning (6:00-12:00) for the farming activities. It is possible to have activities during the weekend, but in that case the free days will be moved to the following week. Additionally, there will be two free days for every worked month.

ACCOMODATION

will be provided on site in a shared room with another volunteer

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

will consist of a pocket money of 5 euros per day. Meals will be prepared and shared with the staff during the activities. The travel expenses will be reimbursed on the basis defined by the European Commission.
