# ASSOCIAZIONE IL CESTO ONLUS

Associazione Il Ce. Sto Onlus has been involved since 1987 in the promotion of integration and social promotion processes among the different ethnicities living in the historical center of Genoa, with particular attention towards minors, second-generation migrants, and other actors in the neighborhood (residents, shopkeepers, schools and institutions).

The association has built a space that empowers educational, recreational, and creative goals among minors of different ethnicities and Italians; stimulates and encourages positive relations between people, encounters, mutual knowledge, and solidarity; provides paths and tolls to value and enforce individuals and community's potential.



The association services include a literacy course for adults, a helpdesk for migrants, the Social Centre for children, the Social Centre for pre-adolescents and adolescents, and cultural animation and training activities.



#### **OUR ACTIVITIES**

#### LUZZATI GARDEN

In 2012 II Ce.Sto has started managing Luzzati Garden, a downgraded area that has been renovated and transformed. In this area, we promote cultural and leisure activities giving life to an alternative place meeting place for locals.

#### CHILDREN AND TEENS

The Social Centre for children and adolescents provides school support and afterschool leisure-time activities. Summer camp activities take place in the city surrounding and involve children and teens.

project includes The an emergency service providing support in the asylum-seeking procedure and medical assistance; a social, working, housing integration and empowerment process for people having subsidiary protection and a hosting project for single persons and families who are being hosted in apartments and provided with services such as literacy, documents issuing, medical assistance and work integration, and a residential community for Separated Children.



#### **PROJECT CONTEXT**

Genova (Genoa) is the most important seaport of the Mediterranean and one of the most important ports in Europe. It is the sixth most populated city in Italy that connects the industrial triangle of Turin and Milan. Its privileged location, as the "door to the Mediterranean", has made Genoa one of the most prosperous financial and commercial centers and one of the most influential in the West.

Genoa has gone through a time of economic and social hardship caused by the de-industrialization and impoverishment of the economy in the last decades. For this reason, it has undertaken a significant process of urban renewal.

The activity of II Ce.Sto is rooted in the historic center of Genoa that developed through a maze of narrow streets and alleys where it is impossible to enter in any other way except on foot. Liguria has always been the destination of arriving migrants, and today more than ever, it includes different cultures often in conflict with each other and local authorities. It is indeed a tough neighborhood, where marginalization and petty crime hinder the process of integration and where IL Ce.Sto has succeeded in spreading the values of tolerance, respect, and mutual understanding.
