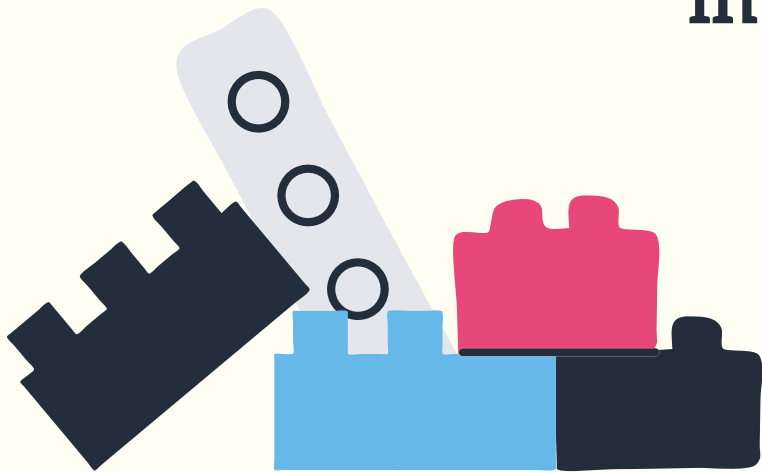


ESC IN AFTER SCHOOL ACTIVITIES IN YOUTH CENTER

WHO WE ARE



Centro QR52 is a youth center in Milan, dedicated to youngsters aged 11-19 from the neighbourhood. In the youth center they can meet their friends, take part in organized activities, play sports and receive support for their homework.



WHO WE ARE

No Borders is an association of ex-volunteers settled in Milan since August 2014 to promote mobility and intercultural learning for youngsters.

We are the coordinating/lead organisation. We manage bureaucratic questions of the project, volunteer's questions, and the flat of volunteers.

We have around 18 ESC volunteers in 10 projects around the region, with topics of non-formal education in youth centres, NGO support, dog shelter, and eco-hostel.





ACTIVITIES

- Help in after-school activities with tweens, teens, and youngsters (in homework, study, or thesis);
- After-school support for primary school children (snack preparation, homework help, and playtime);
- Support and participation in creative, artistic and cultural laboratories with children and youngsters (ecology, web radio and podcasts, juggling, video making, rap, painting, beat-making, etc);
- Support in sports activities, such as tournaments and trainings, in both: logistics and practice;
- Support in organizing and managing evening activities for youngsters (about two times a month);
- Support children and youngsters to take care of the community garden;
- Support in organizing and managing of the group trips and holidays
- In summer period support in summer camps;
- Help in daily routine (eg. shopping for activities, preparing materials, drawing, tidying up..);
- Activities and development of new ideas in order to involve the local community through intercultural meetings and linguistic tandem in English, Italian, and own mother tongue;
- Intercultural events, like regional and international dinners in order to involve the community;
- Dissemination of European opportunities among young people, spreading information through meetings at local level and within the center;
- Support in communication through spreading of information on different websites and social media.



TIMETABLE

Volunteers will have activities from Monday to Friday, for maximum 35 hours per week.

Most of the time the activities will take place from afternoon (around 13:00-15:00) till the evening (19:00).

Availability to volunteer during Saturday and Sunday in case of festivals and events.

Volunteers will have activities 5 days per week, with 2 consecutive days off (normally Saturday and Sunday).

In summer, due to school holidays and summer camps the timetable and hours can change.

Volunteers will have 2 days of vacations per month.

ACCOMODATION

You will live in a DOUBLE room, sharing it with another person of the same gender. There are 2 bathrooms and an eat-in kitchen.

Please note, the location of the center is 1,5 h away from the house.



SUPPORT

Pocket money: 6 euros per day

Food money: 160€ per month

The volunteers will also get a monthly ticket for covering the local transports.

The travel expenses will be reimbursed on the basis defined by the European Commission.

An online Italian language course will be provided.

Volunteers should bring their laptop to work and for studying Italian!
