Centro Tempo per il Barrio is a youth center located in Milan and managed by the organization Tempo per l'Infanzia.

It is dedicated to young people from 11 to 25 years old. Here young people are encouraged to socialize and help with integration of peers from different backgrounds and nationalities.

The center's activities are based on Non-formal education.

The project will take place mainly at the youth center, and sometimes can have a switch in case of events, sport games, activities in local neighborhood, etc.

WHO ARE
WE



No Borders is an association of ex-volunteers settled in Milan since August 2014 to promote mobility and intercultural learning for youngsters.

We are the **coordinating/lead organisation**.

We manage bureaucratic questions of the project, volunteer's questions, and the flat of volunteers.

We have around 18 ESC volunteers in 10 projects around the region, with topics of non-formal education in youth centres, NGO support, dog shelter, and eco-hostel.

TASKS

After-school activities: assisting with homework of youngsters and playing games in free time;

Assisting in workshops for youngsters through non-formal education techniques in the field of arts, culture, music, citizenship, human rights;

Supporting educators in sports activities such as workouts and matches, stimulating team spirit and spreading a healthy lifestyle;

Support in organizing and managing of the study visits, group trips, and summer camps (in summer period);

Dissemination of European opportunities among young people, spreading information through meetings at local level and within the center;

Reporting and promoting the activities of the center: photo, videos, social media.

Optionally, when center organises intercultural events, tandems or free markets, involving local community, volunteers might be asked to assist if needed.



TIMETABLE

Volunteers will have activities from Monday to Friday, for maximum 35 hours per week. Most of the time the activities will take place from early afternoon till the evening.

Availability to volunteer during Saturday and Sunday in case of festivals and events.

Volunteers will have activities 5 days per week, with 2 consecutive days off (normally Saturday and Sunday).

In summer, due to school holidays and summer camps the timetable and hours can change.

Volunteers will have 2 days of vacations per month.

ACCOMODATION

You will share a simple flat in the North part of Milan with 5 other ESC volunteers (you will be the 6th one).

You will live in a DOUBLE room, sharing it with another person of the same gender. There are 2 bathrooms and an eat-in kitchen.

The accommodation is provided by the coordinating organization: Associazione No Borders.

Tempo per il Barrio is in the walking distance from the flat.

SUPPORT

Pocket money: 6 euros per day

Food money: 110€ + **the lunch during the volunteering days will be provided by the Tempo per l'infanzia.**

The volunteers will also get a monthly ticket for covering the local transports.

The travel expenses will be reimbursed on the basis defined by the European Commission.

An online italian language course will be provided.

Volunteers should bring their laptop to work and for studying Italian!
