



## WHO WE ARE



Associazione di Promozione Sociale P.E.CO. was born in Genova in 2013 in order to offer opportunities of international mobility and intercultural learning to genoan and ligurian youths aged between 13 and 30. In particular, P.E.CO. targets young people with fewer opportunities or economically/socially disadvantaged, aiming to offer opportunities to those who usually have less access.

We are the coordinating/lead organisation. We manage bureaucratic questions of the project, volunteer's questions, and the flat of volunteers.

We have around 20 ESC volunteers in several projects around the city of Genova with topics of non-formal education in youth centres and after school activities, and immigration-related projects.



### MHO ME ARE

Centro Storico Ragazzi project started in 2008 stemming from a shared assessment of the needs of Genoa historical centre. It gathers the parish churches belonging to the central-western Curacy of Genoa, consisting in the most downgraded areas of the historical centre, together with some associations active in the support of minors with fewer opportunities.

Centro Storico Ragazzi carries out educational activities for youngsters aged 6-18, who live in or hang out at Genoa historical city centre. The majority of them have foreign nationality, especially Ecuador, Perù and China. Most youngsters we're working with face disadvantaged family environments, difficulties at school, economical obstacles and do not have a stable connection with the context.

Centro Storico Ragazzi is an oratory-school, at the end of each day there is prayer. No one is obliged to be a Christian (in fact they LOVE diversity!).

## OUR ACTIVITIES

Our working methodology is based on the encounter and the care of each child/young person, to whom we offer a space and a time to meet people who they can refer to while we're seeking for cooperation with the family, the school and the other educational agencies.

Despite our religious inspiration, Centro Storico Ragazzi's activities do not have any religious linkage and are addressed to youngsters of all religions, with the aim of favouring not only intercultural but also interreligious dialogue and learning.

The Centre is open 5 days a week, from Monday to Friday, all year except for August.

The activities take place in the spaces offered by all parish churches and associations. In this sense, we applies the approach of "outreach education" thus not having a fixed headquarter.

### PROJECT CONTEXT

Genova (Genoa) is the most important seaport of the Mediterranean and one of the most important ports in Europe. It is the sixth most populated city in Italy that connects the industrial triangle of Turin and Milan. Its privileged location, as the "door to the Mediterranean", has made Genoa one of the most prosperous financial and commercial centers and one of the most influential in the West.

A group of youth aged +18 has been entrusted with a support role in the management of the sport activities, with the double aim of resposibilizing them and providing them with small economical support.

What's Provided?

A shared bathroom with the volunteers Shared kitchen & common areas with other volunteers Accommodation covered by Peco

They will receive pocket money of 6€ per day + food allowance.
They eat 3 times per week in the center.

The travel expenses will be reimbursed on the basis defined by the European Commission.

#### Time

Volunteers will have activities from Monday to Friday, for maximum 35 hours per week.

2 consecutive days off (usually Saturday & Sunday, but subject to change for special events).

In case of a request availability to volunteer during Saturday and Sunday for special events.

Volunteers will have 2 days of vacations per month (with 15 days' notice before).
